Learners move from grade to grade with their age cohort. Some provincial departments provide guidelines to schools to assist with the management of progression. A learner who underperforms to such an extent that he/she would benefit from repeating a grade may only repeat once in a phase. Sufficient evidence of intervention and support should be provided and parents have to be informed timeously.</p>
